



14th Annual Hershey Partnership's Soup Cook-Off

2017 REGISTRATION RULES

Thank you for registering to participate in the Hershey Partnerships Fall Soup Cook Off! Below are some basic ground rules and instructions that you will need to follow. We are looking forward to making this event a great success, and appreciate your participation and support. - 1) We cannot have open flames or burners at the event. All soups should be cooked ahead of time and brought to the event in an electric crock-pot. Crème Brulee torches are acceptable to bring and use. Historically we have averaged approximately 400 + guests at the event. We are doing extra marketing this year, so you may want to bring extra soup in a container in case you run short. Historically participants bring 8-10 quarts of soup. Also, consider bringing your soup already warmed.
- 2) We are expecting approximately 50+ cooks, so the amount of soup you will be giving out will be a very small tasting dish full...holding about 2 or 3 tablespoons. We are supplying the cups and spoons for the tasters. Please bring your own personal serving ladle or spoon and ladle (spoon) rest.
- 3) All chefs need to go to the registration table upon arrival to sign in for the event. A volunteer will take you to your assigned table and help with unloading and any setup needs.
- 4) You will be assigned a table and with seating of 2 cooks per table. You will have some space for coolers or supplies behind the tables. Space permitting professional chefs entering two soups will be provided a full table.
- 5) You are welcome to present your logo tablecloth, business cards or company brochures at your station, but we cannot allow any booths, advertisements, signs or hanging displays.
- 6) It is preferable for you to bring your own extension cords and power strips. Please note what you are bringing on your registration.
- 7) We are asking professional chefs to bring their own supply of tasting cups.

8) We will be providing each cook with a sign that will list your soup, and we can also list your business/company name. All information will be taken from the signup sheet you've filled out on the Hershey Partnership website, so please make sure you are happy with your submitted info. Each category will have a pro and non-pro level including the Jr. Chefs; so please make sure you've listed yourself in the correct category. Pro entries are allowed (2) soups, non-pro (1) soup.

9) The event officially begins at 11am on Saturday October 14th. We will be having a cooks meeting at 10:30am. You can begin set up at 9am, and please arrive to set up no later than 10am! That only leaves a short time to warm the soup, so you should bring your soup already warmed. The event lasts until 2pm, and we will present the awards at 2:30 pm.

10) Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at the event or on the premise.

11) Lastly, the success of this event will depend upon the participation of the cooks. Because of this, we need a very firm headcount and commitment from each participant.
